AUDITION INFORMATION

COMMITMENT TO QUALITY AND CODE OF CONDUCT: Peninsula Family Theater prides itself on its quality productions. To achieve this, expectations are high and a commitment to this production is essential. Because we will be rehearsing and performing on the Sequim School Campus, our cast and crew will be held to the same standards and guidelines as other users groups and school events including but not limited to respect for school property, no smoking or vulgar language, and no food or drink in the auditorium.

REHEARSALS: We expect cast and crew to be at every rehearsal for which they are scheduled. **Attendance, discipline, control and respect are expected of all cast members, regardless of age, even the very young.** We do have a policy that if cast members have more than one unexpected absence (and they do not inform the Director or Musical Director by Facebook message, text, phone call, or e-mail prior to the unexpected absence), they can be terminated from the cast. This would apply also in instances of unruly/disrespectful behavior (toward both people and property). Rehearsals will run Monday through Friday, *typically* 6:00 pm to 9:00 pm. During the final two weeks of production there may be longer rehearsals. A mandatory All Day Saturday rehearsal will run from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Saturday, June 27th.

MANDATORY CAST MEETING: There will be a mandatory Cast Meeting on **May 27th at 7 pm.** Each cast member and, at least, one parent for anyone under 18 must attend this meeting. A wealth of important information will be distributed and discussed.

COSTS: At the Mandatory Cast Meeting, please be prepared to pay your Production Fee (\$10 Non-Refundable that includes student T-shirt) and script deposit (\$25 check made out to Peninsula Family Theater). Deposit will not be cashed but will be held until the end of the production and returned to you when the script is returned. Other costs that you may incur are for show merchandise, tickets, make-up, shoes, socks, hair styling items, etc. Order forms to order additional T-shirts for \$10 will be available **ONLY** at the Mandatory Cast Meeting.

PHOTO/VIDEO POLICY: Per contractual agreement with the publishers from whom we purchase performance rights, and to whom we pay substantial royalties, video and audiotaping of any rehearsal or performance is prohibited.

VOLUNTEER TIME: All cast and crew will be expected to volunteer in some capacity. We take this very seriously, as without this help, we could not possibly complete all the backstage work required to stage a production of the quality we are so proud to produce. More information will be provided at the Mandatory Cast Meeting.

AUDITION DAY: Come prepared to sing **1 verse and 1 chorus** of a song from musical theater repertoire that showcases your vocal abilities. All auditions should have accompaniment i.e. sheet music, CD, MP3, etc. A pianist will be provided.
